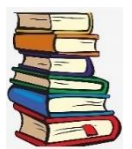

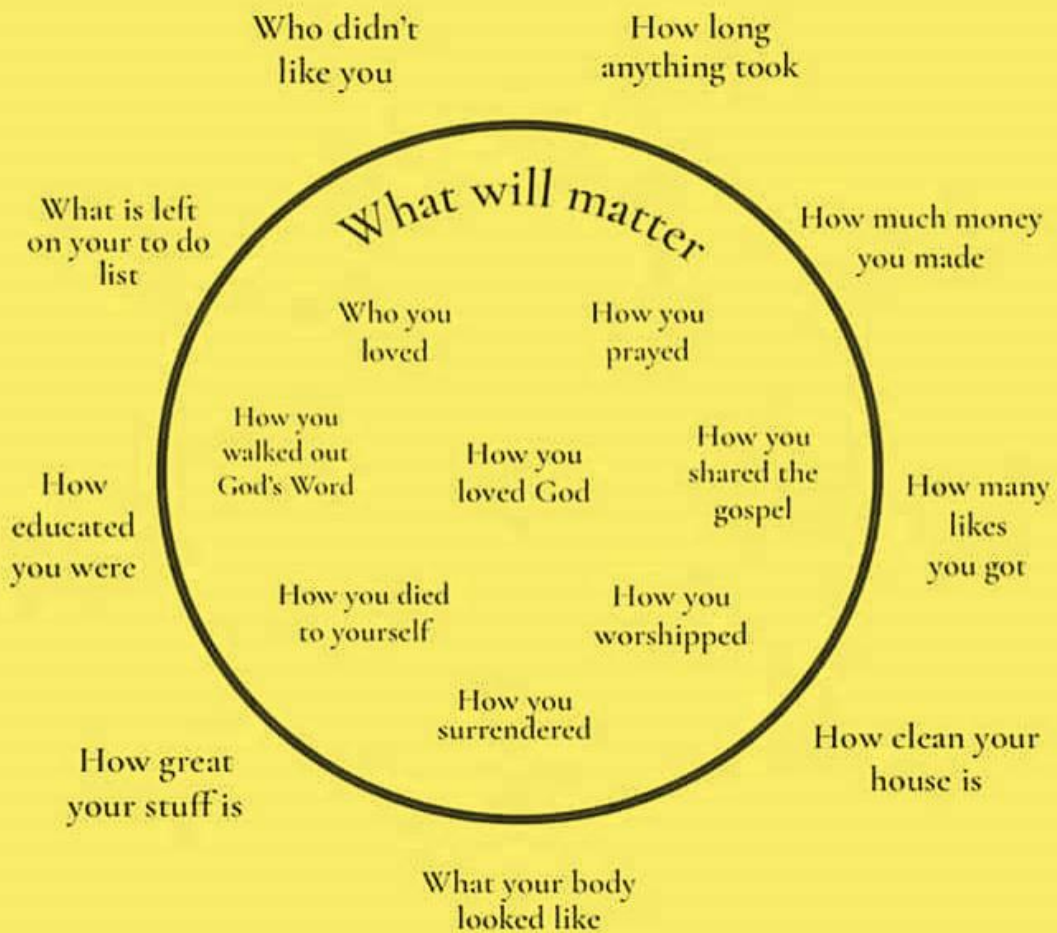

POTPOURRI HOME & GARDENING CLUB

Just look at how we are being rewarded for our work over the past months. Everything is blooming and looking so beautiful.

GARDENING TIPS

- Plant a Goldcrest: it has all the characteristics of a good conifer, a nice shape, bright golden yellow foliage that when bruised, smells like lemon, and enough of a pine-like appearance to stand in as a Christmas tree if needed. Use Christmas lights in the plant and have a beautiful Christmas tree in your garden.
- Sprinkle compost and bone meal on bare spots in your garden and sow seeds for summer flowers such as Marigolds, Cosmos, Sunflowers and Zinnias.
- If you want your Amarilla bulbs to flower for Christmas, buy them now and keep them in the vegetable drawer of your fridge until 6 weeks before Christmas. Plant them and you will be rewarded with beautiful flowers on Christmas Day.
- Prune 'fynbos' neatly after flowering including Leucospermums, Confetti bushes, Ericas and Proteas. Allow the leaves of bloomed spring bulbs to turn yellow and die naturally. Continue to feed and water bulbs you want to take out so they can store food for next year's blooms.
- Now is the time to plant fragrant Jasmine, Hibiscus, Inka lilies, Dahlias, Gardenia and Bougainvillas.
- Keep newly planted summer bulbs moist and start feeding with bulb food as soon as leaves begin to emerge.
- Prune Hibiscus to encourage them to bloom in late summer and autumn.
- Watering directly on the ground instead of overhead eliminates evaporation and also prevents diseases in hot humid weather. Make your own seepage hose by drilling holes in the garden hose.
- Plant shrubs such as Cape Camphor, September bush and Pentas for birds and butterflies.
- Examine all members of the Lily family for lily bugs. They love to work at night and then destroy your lilies. Treat with contact insecticide.

WATER SAVING TIPS

- ❖ Mulch reduces water evaporation from the soil and keeps plant roots cool in the heat of the day.
- ❖ Hydrating granules absorb the excess water and store it for when needed.
- ❖ Water early in the morning so that evaporation is reduced and plants can absorb the moisture during the day.
- ❖ Zoning plants with the same water needs will save water.
- ❖ Don't throw away the water that vegetables are cooked in, it is full of nutrients and will give your indoor plants more shine. Avoid water that contains spices, salt or fat.

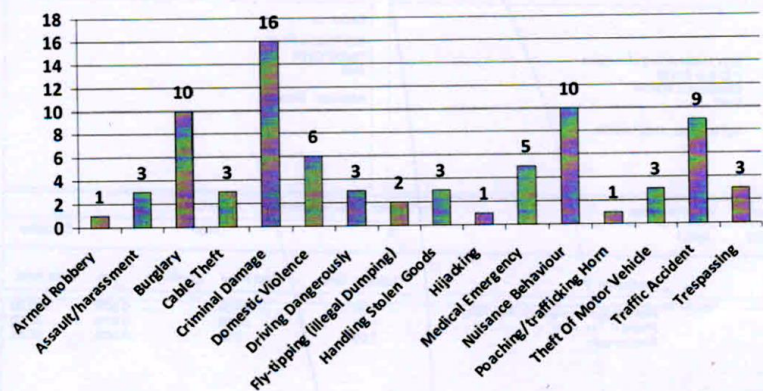

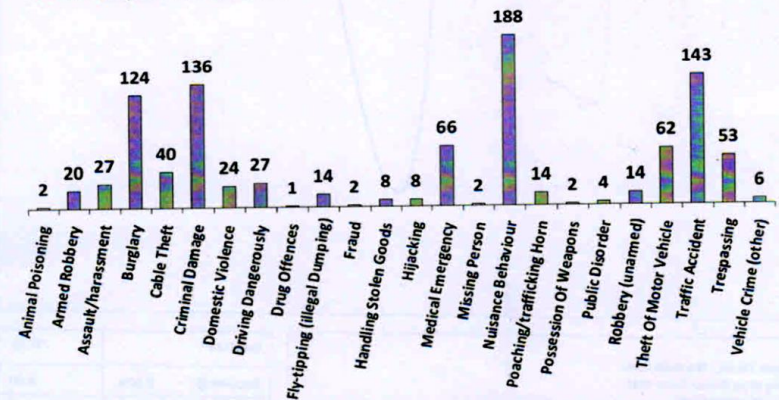

Actual Crime Types (Reported) Year-to-Date - 1 October 2023 to 30 September 2024



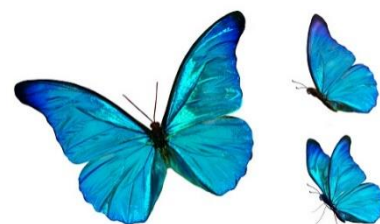
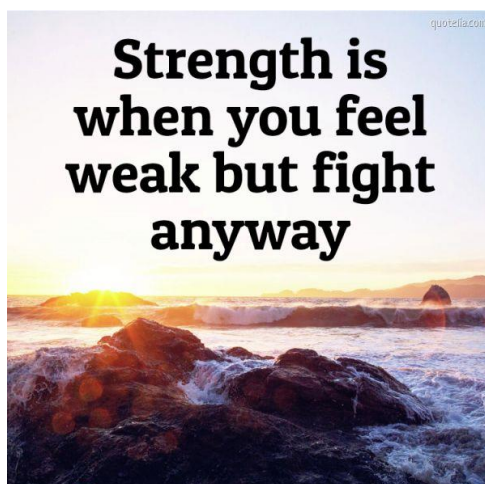
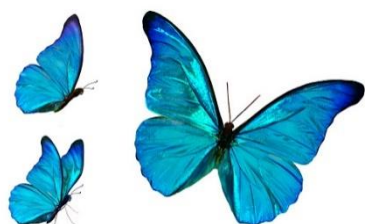

Julie Andrews Turning 79 - this is hysterical!

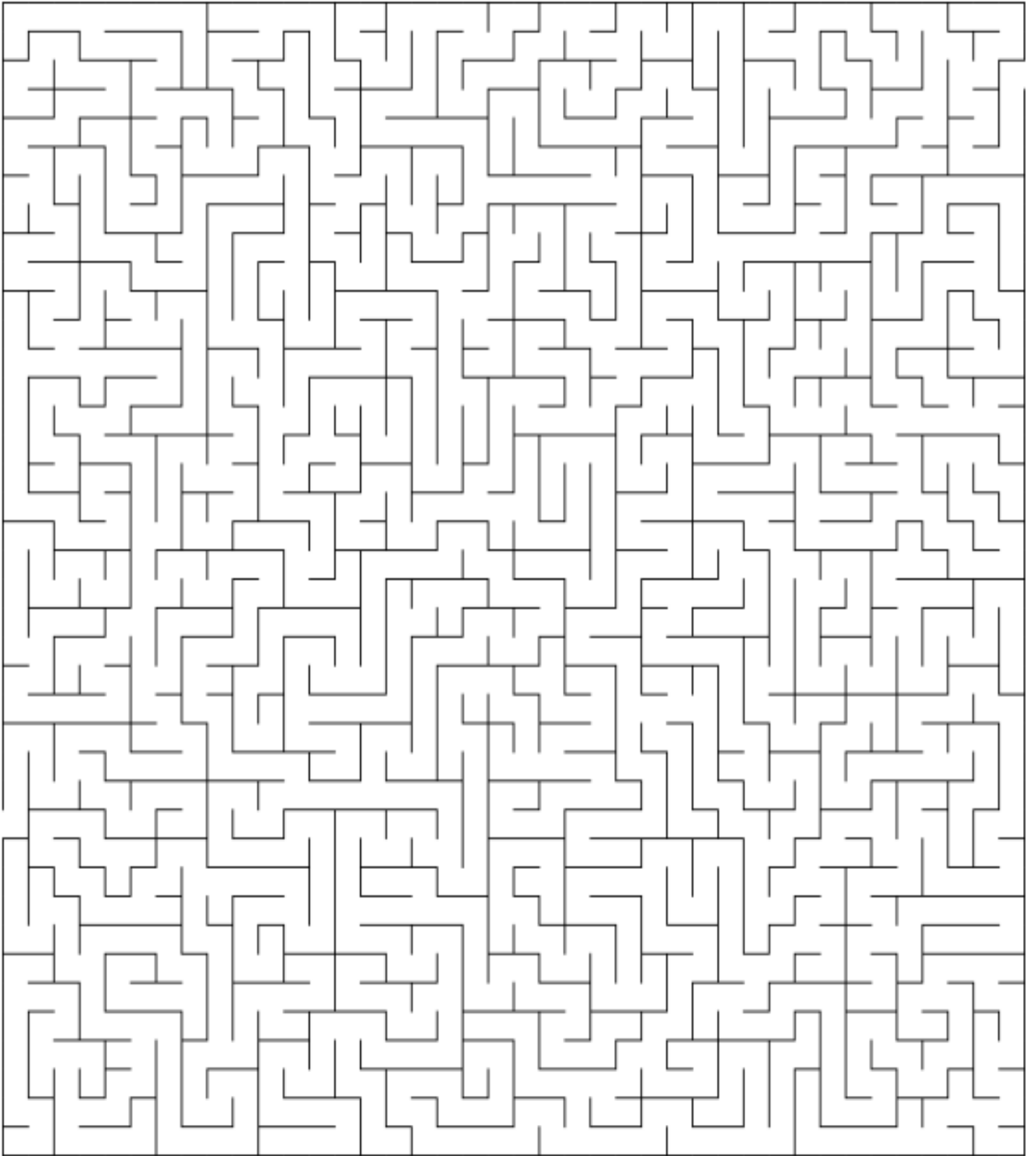
